Adaobi Nwofor - Our GRSP Student Gave A Special Insight About Her Home Country

from being shown. I've included a few of the slides from her presentaion below.



NIGERIA

There are 250 ethnic groups in Nigeria each with their own culture and traditions including different languages. There are 3 major tribes in Nigeria:

Hausa/Fulani (29%)- North

Igbo (18%)- South East

Yoruba (21%)- South West

These tribes make up to 70% of the country's population. The Hausa/Fulanis are predominantly Muslims, the Igbos are predominantly Christians while the Yorubas are a blend of both.

NOTABLE PEOPLE IN NIGERIA

- Femi Anikulapo-Kuti popularly known as Fela is Nigeria's most famous Afro-beat legend. He was both a musician and a human rights activist who spoke against corruption through his music.
- Through his music, he constantly challenged the government to transparency and honest leadership.
- Famous playwright and novelists, Wole Soyinka (1986 Nobel prize winner in literature) and Chinua Achebe (writer of Things Fall Apart) are great writers who through their writings have been able to promote the true African spirit/culture and bring literary awards and recognition to Nigeria and Africa as a whole.
- Other notable Nigerian writers well known internationally include Chimamanda Ngozi Adichie, John Pepper Clark and Ken Saro Wiwa.
