On Monday, October 7, 2016, Ken Kirk, author of "Messages in Handlebar" will speak to the Rotary Club of Sandy Springs about the French Resistance during WWII. Here is an excerpt from his website: " Ken is a native of Marietta, Georgia, and holds degrees from Georgia Tech and Georgia State. He has been

who contributed the most to the eradication of polio during the period 1992 to 1995. He has served on the City of Marietta's Board of Education and rewrote Georgia's "No pass; no play" statute. He served as chair of his county's art museum during its finest hours.

As an athlete, he held the SEC freshman record for the javelin throw, was a founder of The Atlanta Track Club and was national chairman and national champion in masters track & field. Ken has written a book, "Messages in Handlebars", about the youngest French resistance fighter to receive the Croix de Guerre, Jean-Jacques Auduc, which Claire has translated into French with many copies being sold. Ken has presented his book to many clubs and organizations. The British Ambassador to France is an endorser of this book.
